

## **Blacksburg Community Band Founder's Scholarship: In honor of Ed Schwartz**

### Purpose

- Foster the desire in high school students to become lifelong musicians, regardless of the profession they choose to pursue.
- The scholarship is to be used toward music lessons, instrument repair, instrument purchase, or tuition.

### Eligibility

- Students currently in grades 9-12
- Reside in Montgomery, Pulaski, Floyd, or Giles Counties, and the City of Radford
- Play a woodwind, brass, or percussion instrument (percussion does not include piano)
- Currently participates in a music program
- Financial need is not a consideration
- Relatives of the Scholarship Selection Committee are not eligible

### Criteria

- Commitment to music
- Commitment to community
- Interest in continuing to play in the future

### Submission Requirements

- Application
  - Academics
  - Music & School Activities
  - Service to Others / Community Service
  - Additional Accomplishments
- 250 Word Essay describing passion for music
- One recommendation from a teacher, band director, guidance counselor, or advisor

### Timing/Selection Process

- Application Deadline: February 18, 2019 (postmark deadline)
- Applications shared with Scholarship Committee
- Scholarship Committee meets to select recipient (recipient selected by March 25th)
- Scholarship recipient contacted
- Recipient awarded scholarship at Spring Concert: May 5, 2019

### Amount

- One \$500 scholarship

### Award Distribution

- Funds will be paid by the Blacksburg Community Band to the music teacher of the recipient's choice or to a school for lessons or tuition. If used for instrument repair or purchase, the awarded funds will be paid by the Blacksburg Community Band for reimbursement of expense incurred within one year of receiving the scholarship. An exception on the one year timeframe may be granted on a case-by-case basis
